Grants Approved in Greater Wellington Region

Overview of Approved Grants

Te Uru Rakau has helped fund:

- Approximately 1,218 hectares of new planting in the Greater Wellington Region (GWR)
- Across a number of projects, 23 in total.
- Species include; Eucalyptus fastigata and general Eucalyptus species
- Exotic species such as Giant Redwoods, Macrocarpa, and Pinus radiata
- Along with mixed Indigenous trees and Manuka.

The planting projects were scheduled for the 2019, 2020 and 2021 planting seasons.

This equates to a total investment in the GWR from the One Billion Trees Fund of \$5.2 million.

• 23,073 ha of Post-89 ETS forestland has been registered in the ETS @ 30/09/2020
